A Pastoral Letter

From the College of Bishops of the Holy Catholic Church - Anglican Rite (also known as the Anglican Rite Catholic Church), to all the faithful throughout the jurisdiction:

Greetings in the Name of Our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

Following his recent ill health, the Rt. Rev. A. David Seeland has resigned as bishop ordinary of the Diocese of the Pacific & Southwest. His resignation has been accepted by the College of Bishops effective upon the enthronement of Bp. King.

The College of Bishops, under the apostolic canons, has elected the Rt. Rev. Henry Joseph King as bishop ordinary of the Diocese of the Pacific & Southwest and set the date of his enthronement as September 20, 2008.

Further, the College of Bishops has elected Fr. Anthony Rasch to serve as bishop coadjutor of the Diocese of the Pacific & Southwest and set the date of his consecration as September 20, 2008.
